Dear President Hasenbalg:

The Department of the Treasury recently conducted a high level review of the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority in order to develop recommendations targeted at achieving financial sustainability at the Authority. The results of the review are attached for your consideration.

Because of changes in the Authority's operating model in recent years, the Authority has been unable to effectively support its legacy costs and ongoing operational budget without significant resources from the State of New Jersey. In order to reduce the near-term and long-term State financial subsidy, Treasury focused its review on evaluating various ideas for reducing the operation of the Authority while balancing resource needs related to contractual requirements of the stadium ground lease. The Treasury team met with your staff, had numerous telephonic conversations and exchanged information over the course of eight weeks in order to evaluate various options to achieve and maintain a financially sustainable operating model for the Authority.

We want to thank you and your senior staff for cooperating with Treasury over the last several weeks and for providing the Treasury team with access to individuals and information.
